### Boundary Changes for 2017-2018

#### Boundary Changes for Elementary Schools in the Bingham, Riverton and Herriman Areas

After months of extensive work and public input from parents, the Board of Education voted on boundaries for two new elementary schools in Herriman and South Jordan.

Based on parent and patron feedback, the Board chose a modified 'Option C' for the boundaries, which includes adjustments between Herriman and Butterfield Canyon Elementary Schools.

The Board voted to transition Eastlake, Daybreak, Midas Creek, Silver Crest and Welby Elementary Schools from a year-round to a traditional calendar for the 2017-18 school year. The Board previously approved moving Monte Vista and Elk Meadows from a year-round to a traditional calendar. Both new elementary schools in Herriman and South Jordan will open on a traditional calendar.

In addition, it was decided that there will be no boundary or calendar changes at Fox Hollow or Hayden Peak Elementary Schools for the 2017-18 school year. No additional boundary or calendar changes will be considered at this time.
