4. Review Final Land Trust data from 2016-2017

- 95% of students made at least one years worth of growth in Language Arts, which was our goal

5. School Improvement Plan for 2017-2018

- Silver Crest will have the same goal for the School Improvement Plan this year as we had with our Land Trust plan. The goal is to have 95% of students achieve at least one years worth of growth in Language Arts.
- Change focus to Dibels for the lower grades, and pre- and post-tests for the older grades

8. SNAP Plan Update

- Amanda and Jaimi met with city planner and the police chief about moving the cross walk on the south end. The City Planner, like our SCC, has concerns about the crosswalk being moved further east where the light is. If children cross at a light, we lose the ability to use the school zone slower speed signs. That is an added danger as well as crossing the southwest entrance of the rec center.
- The current proposal to the city is to keep the cross walk where it currently is and put a flashing sign in the median so it is more visible to those coming out of the intersection at Rosecrest Blvd.
- To decrease traffic using the rec center parking lot as a through street, a proposal to put in two arm guards in the parking lot that are down during school beginning/ending times.
- On the north side of the school, at the entrance to Tuscany considerations of making that intersection a three way stop are being made.
- Silver Crest has asked the district for an extension on having the SNAP Plan.
