 - Ideas for potential subcommittees
 - i. **Safe Walking Routes Subcommittee:** Goal to update Safe Walking routes and suggest needed changes, assess safety concerns, engage with and advocate community concerns with school and city. And report information to the SCC

ii. **Land Trust Research Subcommittee:** goal to help gather school testing data, look at other school Land Trust plan, etc to prepare to write the School Land Trust Plan for the 25-26 school year and present finding to the SCC prior to writing the plan

8. Information about Target Supports & Intervention for students with disabilities and multi language learners - Patty Bowen

- o The school was given funding to support students that were testing low in certain academic areas. They did some research why the students were testing lower and determined that it was due to attendance and excessive absences. They will be using the funding to hire a 17-25 hour/week Attendance specialist that will focus on engaging the family, communicating with parents and students to educate and encourage better attendance and also to assess barriers and needs to aid in better attendance. Job position will be posted within the next few days. Patty wanted to share this information with the SCC. No voting of anything was needed.

9. **Announcement: UDOT Safe Walking Route Grant - Lacey Taylor**

- o Herriman City DID apply for a safe walking route grant to help fund improvements to our safe walking routes in 2 areas 1) adding a needed sidewalk along the backside of the JL Sorenson Rec Center where students travel to and from school and 2) to fix the crosswalk intersection at Herriman Main and Herriman Rose Blvd. Proposed changes to this intersection would turn it into a limited left turn and also create a divided crosswalk with a safe zone in the center. The city was approved for the grant and now will be getting community feedback about the changes. If the grant is fully approved, funding would be effective for 2027 but construction could start in late 2026.
