1. Welcome - Lacey Taylor, *SCC Chair*
2. Public Comment: None
3. Approve minutes from last SCC on 01/16/2026

4. Discuss and Vote on whether to amend SCE R of O&P to decrease SCE SCC size
 - o Holly said she would ask Mike A if a range of members is permissible for our council to list a range of members in our Rules of Order and Procedure or if we just need to downsize.
 - o Determine description for our Rules of Order and Procedure- We decided to leave it open. We will state the new smaller number of council members, but also list that if there is interest, the larger size of the council that we previously agreed too. This will allow our council to grow/shrink as interest fluctuates.

5. Safe Routes Report – Holly Bagley, *SCE Principal*
 - o Update from meeting with district/police/city engineer
 - i. Good News. Fence on the North side has been put into a special project with the district. Since it is on school property, they will cover it.
 - ii. No faux barriers will be put in on the East side
 - iii. Lines will be repainted to hopefully make pick up movements more clear.
 - iv. City clarified that the reduced speed on Main St for Utah rules has to be tied to an unsafe crosswalk. Since the city has deemed the lighted crossing as safe and the official safe walking route, they will not be reducing the speed limit on Main St.
 - o Condensed results from [Safe Routes Survey](#)
 - i. **Key Findings/Recommendations:**
 1. 59% of respondents would walk, scooter bike to school **MORE** if the safe route could safely be reinstated at Herriman Rose Blvd & Herriman Main St
 2. From these respondents, there could be over **50% reduction** of vehicles in every Access Zone and Rec Center during pick up if route were returned to former intersection.
 3. Many parents noted they felt the old route was safer when compared to the new route and the safety concerns it has created.

4. Overall, parents are concerned about the speed of traffic, unsafe habits, and prolonged exposure along Main St.
 - We discussed the possibility of a bus route for Area 10 (if safe route meetings busing requirements)
6. Wellness Subcommittee Flyer
 - A plug and chug newsletter would be easiest to make this a realistic resource to circulate. Patty Bowen, the former principal had tried this before. Parent Square may have changed the possibility of our newsletter being seen/appreciated. We decided that if we did our own newsletter it would be a Wellness NEwsletter.
 - We also discussed it staying with a SCC update newsletter like the one Lacey made before. We could do monthly or quarterly updates. Ultimately we decided to discuss this further next year and let the new council determine what they felt would want.
7. Review and Approve SCE Land Trust Plan for 25-26 School Year - Holly Bagley
 - Goal: 65% of students to be at typical/better growth according to Acadience Testing. (Teachers have progress monitoring to help them keep track of where students are.)
 - Plan Specifics (Funds allotted to):
 - i. Hire 8 walk to read assistants (1 more than before)
 - ii. Assistants: PE Teacher & Fund 20% of Music Teacher Salary
 - iii. "Special" classes so teachers can meet to plan and discuss improvement
 - iv. Day for Subs for teachers to have ½ day planning; Would like this to occur twice a year
 - v. IXL Software
 - vi. Technology related to supplies (chromebooks, laptops, etc)
 - vii. One extra aide for 6th grade; to help with testing too (Current Aide numbers for other grades K-3, 1st-2, 2nd-2, 3rd-1, 4th-1, 5th-½)
