1. Welcome - Lacey, *SCC Chair* - 3:42 pm
2. Public Comment: None
3. Approve minutes from last SCC on 11/19/2025

4. Review & Discuss 2025-26 SCC Council Structure:
 - Caitlin Hadley texted Lacey to let her know she would be stepping down from the SCC.
 - The council discussed the benefits and downfalls of expanding the council. Finding parent volunteers has been very difficult. We discussed the advantage of having a teacher from a higher grade represented when we discuss Land Trust Funds. While we would love to have a larger SCC, we discussed shrinking back to a council of 4 parent members and 2 Silver Crest employees.
 - We will vote on this at our March 11th meeting. Mike Anderson from the district suggested our council size stay the same for three years before changing.
 - Katie Sims attended our meeting as is willing to be a parent member. We cannot officially put her on the council unless we have another parent member join our council.
 - Holly is going to call Mike Anderson and ask about having a range of members (5 members)
5. Update from SAFE Routes Subcommittee
 - The subcommittee suggested repainting the lines in the drop off areas
 - Holly was going to reaching out to district to ask about North side fence to discourage pedestrian crossing in the parking lot
 - Ask if the flashing signal can come back for reduced speed on Main St.
 - We discussed the new information from the City Hall Council Work meeting that was held in December. The city is uncertain if they will accept the UDOT Safe Routes Grant money. If they accept the money, the safe walking route would have to return to the intersection of Herriman Main St and Herriman Rose Blvd upon project completion.
 - We discussed that the safe route has created more unsafe behavior all around the school. Our current route has increased our vehicular traffic all around the school and discouraged walking. This is in direct conflict with the Purpose of the safe walking route as prescribed on saferoutes.utah.gov.

- Lacey drafted up a survey to send parents about the Walking Route and drop off zones. It will be circulated to parents in English and Spanish.
 - The subcommittee will meet again on Jan 28th at 3:40 pm to review the survey data
- Holly emailed the district safety coordinator and asked him to come observe school pick up at our school.

6. Update from Wellness Committee

- o Preston held a meeting with the Wellness Committee.
 - i. The purpose of the committee is to support social, emotional, and overall well-being of students by increasing transparency, awareness, and access to wellness supports at SCE.
 - ii. We considered the current supports at SCE/Jordan District
 - 1. Wellness room, counselor, psychologists, Noble Knights, STEM Internet safety week, SAFEUT app to talk to a therapist, Mobile Crisis Outreach website, 9-8-8, etc
 - iii. and possible supports for the future
 - 1. Newsletter, wellness landing site (Wellness Blog) on SCE webpage, Student Council Involvement/Video, lessons in the classroom, handouts to home, Posters for students to see (Ways to make a friend, Talk to a counselor, etc,) QR codes for parents to scan for more information, a Counselor Corner on the newsletter with feedback specifically from Mr. Davis.
 - iv. Mental Health in general and in relation to Technology Use was addressed.
 - 1. We discussed AI in the classroom, teaching parents about having talking points with their students, possibly making a survey to gauge wellness needs.
 - 2. We learned that school AI has limited access to students. The district has a notification system called BARK that alerts district CC admin, counselor, and sometimes the psychologist if unsafe behavior is happening on a students chromebook. Parents are also notified.
 - 3. Teachers also have access to GoGuardian that allows them to watch the screens of their students.
 - v. Lacey contacted Shanell Hooper to learn more about the district Wellness resources. She said using all information at <https://wellness.jordandistrict.org/resources/> is ok for our school to use without prior approval. Beyond that, any wellness information we would like to reference/circulate (ex. Stanford drug safety website discussed at our last SCC meeting) needs to first be sent to our principal for review. The principal then submits it to her own boss for final approval.

- vi. We feel looping in Mr. Davis to have his input on what the students/parents need more support with at our school would be very helpful.
- vii. Preston is going to look into making a survey and what the questions would be. He will also plan a follow up meeting with the Wellness subcommittee to finalize what supports we can begin to add to our school.

7. Review and Discuss Teacher Survey

- o Holly consolidated the survey and made the questions more pertinent to the feedback she was seeking from teachers.
- o We suggested adding a foreword that there is an increase to the Land Trust funds so as the teachers make recommendations, they may be encouraged in making suggestions to utilize funds.
- o Feedback from the survey will be reviewed when completed at the next SCC meeting as pertains to the Land Trust Funds.

8. LAND Trust/TSSA Funds Information - Holly Bagley

- o Land trust - \$183 awarded per student - (20% increase)
- o TSSA Funds - \$ 201 per student; this money has been used to fund aides in the past

9. Draft ideas for SCE Land Trust Plan for 26-27 School Year

- o Due to time constraints, we decided to push this to our next SCC meeting.
- o Everyone has been asked to **RESEARCH IDEAS** on ways we can use our Land Trust Funds.
- o Land trust plan is due March 20th
- o As a whole, the district wants to improve reading levels as a whole.
