8 Safe Walking Routes (SNAP)

a. Member of the council indicated a concern with the amount of time it takes to pick-up students. Ann Pessetto will discuss using the south drop-off and pick-up lane with the kindergarten teachers.

b. Members of council discussed the south carpool area. Concerns were voiced with having to make right-turn out of south carpool sending cars to the north carpool. Others voiced concerns with not knowing about the south carpool lane. A member of council asked if the carpool lane can be used if only dropping off one student. Ann Pessetto will send out an email to parents clarifying use of south carpool lane with map to indicate traffic flow.

c. Jaimi Brewer joined the meeting at 7:30 pm and introduced herself to the SCC. Jaimi answered addressed concerns with traffic on the rec center during school dismissal and south parking lot.

9 Review of Land Trust Plan and money allocation for this year.

a. Ann Pessetto reviewed how funding was allocated in 2018-2019 and for the current school year 2019-2020

b. The council asked questions about teacher retention and reasons why teachers left last school year. Ann Pessetto reviewed reasons for teachers leaving last school year which was related to boundary changes, new schools opening, and family/personal reasons.

c. Ann Pessetto answered questions about the Specials program and explained the different topics taught in the program.

d. Ann Pessetto answered questions about technology needs and purchases. 4th through 6th graders have 1:1 access to laptops. Additional technology purchased is to increase access to younger grades (K-3).

e. Ann Pessetto answered questions about role of SCC related to explained that the SCC will make decisions on how Trust Funds will be spent in the 2021-2022 school year.
